- Must be in good standing with Indiana University, Bloomington campus, with no outstanding tuition bills, fines or fees.
- Must be a third or fourth year student majoring in the School of Business.
- Must be an individual who has distinguished himself with extra-curricular activities.
- Must demonstrate capacity for and commitment to hard work.
- Must possess superior oratory capabilities.
