### **Kovener Award**

#### **2021 Nomination Form**

The deadline for submitting nominations for this award is MARCH 1. Nomination forms are to be submitted by e-mail to both the Chapter's undergraduate VP for Scholarship and the Wrangler Foundation Kovener Award chairman, Ward Weber at: wardweber4@gmail.com.

The Kovener Award was established by the chapter in 2011 as the chapter's highest recognition of the member who has "given back" the most to the chapter, Greeks generally, and the University in the spirit of alumnus Ronald Kovener. Any undergraduate member of the Indiana Chapter who is current in payment of fees and fines may use the accompanying form to nominate up to five fellow undergraduate members of the chapter for this award each year during the month of February. A separate form must be submitted for each nominee. Self-nomination is also permitted.

A nomination is similar to making a "like" on Facebook but the nomination may also specify why the brother nominated deserves to receive the award. Activities and events that may qualify the member for the award may have occurred at any time during the nominee's chapter membership; qualifying activities and events are not limited to the current academic year. Compensated activities may not be included.

Promptly after March 1, a committee established by the chapter president and chaired by the chapter's VP of scholarship will review the nominations received. The committee will consider the number of nominations each member has received and will consider the scope, significance, quality and cumulative effect of the activities and events enumerated in the nominations. The committee lists, in order, the 5 most qualified brothers to receive the award and sends this list to the Wrangler Foundation Kovener Award Chairman for verification and selection of the Kovener Award recipient. The Kovener Award Selection Committee reserves the right to withhold making the award in the event there are fewer than 5 qualified brothers nominated for consideration to receive the award.

The compiled list of brotherhood and service activities by chapter members on these nomination forms will be a complete, sound, verifiable source of data for publicity about the activities of the chapter and its members.

Kovener served for more than 20 years as the Indiana Chapter's alumni treasurer or president, designed and oversaw installation of many improvements to the chapter house including the great room fireplace surround with stained glass crest, poop deck, all main floor rooms, bathroom renovation, and whole house air conditioning, created and oversaw the Wrangler Foundation "Build for Brotherhood" fund raising campaign that raised over half a million dollars to benefit the chapter and its members, was founding Secretary-Treasurer of the revived Alumni Inter-Fraternity Council, created and compiled for 10 years a survey of operating data about IU fraternity chapters, and served in a wide variety of other chapter and campus activities and roles.
